

SOUTHERN UTAH JR. LIVESTOCK SHOW SCHOLARSHIP

The Sevier County Junior Livestock Scholarship committee is taking applications for scholarships for university, college or technical education programs.

- To be eligible for the scholarship, youth must have had a livestock exhibit in the Southern Utah Jr. Livestock Show three of the last five years.
- Applicants must be graduating from high school in the spring of 2018. Youth not planning to attend school in the fall of 2018, but plan to enroll in the future should apply now and if awarded, the scholarship amount will be deferred until the student enrolls. **However, deferral will expire 30 months after being awarded.**
- A minimum of 2.5 GPA (**copy of original transcript is required**).
- Applications will be evaluated based on Junior Livestock program involvement, financial need, career goals, leadership experiences, involvement in extra curricular programs, and work experience.
- Applicants will be judged on point values.
- The amount of the scholarship award is dependent on the number of qualified recipients. Scholarship is valid only toward tuition, fees, and books at an accredited college, university or technical/vocational school.
- Finalists may be asked to attend an interview.
